There were no visitors/guests present at the inservice.

Brad Turner made the motion and Julie Wollerman seconded the motion, to approve the minutes of the February 6, 2018 inservice. The motion passed by 11 yes and zero no roll call votes.

Jennifer Garrison made the motion and Brad Turner seconded the motion, to approve the February bills and financial reports. The motion passed by 11 yes and zero no roll call votes.

There were no additions to the agenda.

The Director took the Economic Interest Statements to the inservice for the BOC members to sign. He informed the members that the Regional System secretary would take the statements to the Fayette County Clerk's office. A stamped receipt would be mailed to the members and a copy would be retained at the Regional System office.

Vandalia's Parent/Teacher conferences were held on February 5, 2018. Parents of the Okaw students had the opportunity to meet with their child's teacher.

The contract for the Director, Nick Casey, was approved by the Vandalia School Board at their meeting in February. A copy of the contract was enclosed in the Board of Control packet. A motion to approve the Director's contract was made by Jason Bauer and seconded by Mike Shackelford. The original contract was signed by the BOC chairperson and secretary.

The Director reported that ISBE had proposed the FY18-19 Career and Technical Education and Agricultural Education budgets at the same level as last year.

An update was given on the Okaw Building Trades project. The flooring and trim work were being installed.

The rep from Hobart Institute of Welding Technology had been to the Okaw AVC in February to speak to the students about opportunities at the college.

The EFE provides Career Cruising for counselors in the region for use in developing Individual Career Plans for students. Hillsboro, Nokomis, Panhandle and Pana counselors will be provided with access to the software next year.

Okaw enrollment cards had been coming in from the schools. Scheduling will begin when all cards have been received.

Fayette County CEO is scheduled to begin in the fall of 2018 for students in Brownstown, Ramsey, St. Elmo and Vandalia.

One hundred seventeen Okaw students were signed up in January for Dual Credit with Kaskaskia and Lake Land colleges.

A motion was made by Julie Wollerman and seconded by Aaron Hopper, to adjourn the inservice at 11:04 a.m. The motion passed by a unanimous voice vote.
