PA 94-0600: During each academic year, schools must conduct a minimum of 3 school evacuation drills to address and prepare students and school personnel for fire incident. One of the 3 school evacuation drills shall require the participation of the appropriate local fire department or district. During each academic year, schools must conduct a minimum of one bus evacuation drill. During each academic year, schools must conduct a minimum of one severe weather and shelter-in-place drill to address and prepare students and school personnel for possible tornado incidents and may conduct additional severe weather and shelter-in-place drills to account for other incidents, including without limitation earthquakes or hazardous materials. PA 95-1015: During each academic year, schools must conduct one law enforcement drill in accordance with the school's current emergency and crisis plans. The drill must be done on days when students are present. P.A. 98-0048 Law enforcement drill shall include a school shooting incident and must be held within the first 90 days of school even if the school and law enforcement cannot agree on a date.
