Now You Get to Choose Your High School Equivalency Test

For the first time in Illinois history, residents can choose what test they take on their path towards earning the Illinois High School Equivalency Certificate. The Illinois Community College Board recently approved the TASC test to be administered throughout the state.

Subject Areas

The TASC test assesses five subject areas including Reading, Writing, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. You can take the TASC test on paper or computer, and in English or Spanish.

Cost

The TASC test make getting you High School Equivalency affordable. The testing fee for all 5 sections in Illinois is only \$92. You also have the option to take one section of the TASC test at a time and pay only \$18.40 per section. The TASC test also offers you a reduced retake fee of \$8 per section for up to 2 retakes after your initial test.

Registration and Scoring

Once you register at Illinois.TASCTest.com you will have access to your online profile which allows you to register for tests and review results. Computer-based testing scores for all machine-scored items are available in as little as one hour; complete scores are available within 3 business days. Paper-and-pencil-based test scores are available within 5 days or less.

Benefits

The TASC test provides you with an affordable option to receive your State of Illinois High School Equivalency Certificate. Once you pass both the TASC test and the Illinois Constitution test you will then be prepared for new career opportunities or to continue your education. U.S. colleges and universities accept results from the TASC test as a state-certified qualification for admission.
