

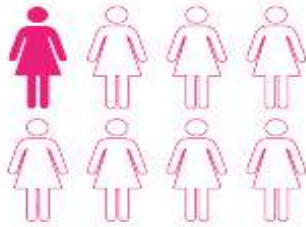

Eligibility

A person is eligible for **Free Breast and Cervical** screenings if the following criteria is met:

Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Services

- 40-64 years of age (**Breast Cancer**) *
- 21-64 years of age (**Cervical Cancer**)
- Uninsured, Underinsured, have a Deductible or need help finding a Doctor
- * Younger Breast Symptomatic (19-39)
 - Can be approved for free services
- * Women older than 64
 - If not eligible to receive Medicare Part A and B, can be approved for free services
